Interpretation:

NC (National Curriculum) Reading – Current attainment is 5 Developing (31-64%). This means that the child is achieving at the 'Developing' stage of the year 5 curriculum and has achieved between 31% and 64% of the NC objectives. Attainment is shaded light blue because this is **Above** the expected attainment for this stage in the year. Progress is **Expected** and therefore shaded light green because the child is progressing along their 'colour-to-colour' pathway (see below)

NC (National Curriculum) Writing – Current Attainment is 5 Beginning (0-30%). This means that the child is achieving at the 'Beginning' stage of the year 5 curriculum and has achieved between 0% and 30% of the NC objectives. Attainment is shaded dark green because this is **Just above** the expected attainment for this stage in the year. Progress is also **Just above** expected and therefore shaded dark green because at some point since the beginning of the year the child has moved up a colour band in their progression pathway (see below).

NC (National Curriculum) Maths – Current Attainment is 5 Beginning (0-30%). This means that the child is achieving at the 'Beginning' stage of the year 5 curriculum and has achieved between 0% and 30% of the NC objectives. Attainment is shaded dark green because this is **Just above** the expected attainment for this stage in the year. Progress is also **Just above** expected and therefore shaded dark green because at some point since the beginning of the year the child has moved up a colour band in their progression pathway (see below).
