The canopy leaper is a mammal and lives in the Australian rain forest.

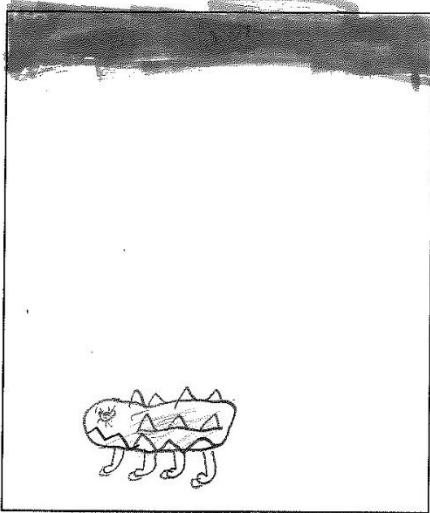
What it looks like
