Terms and conditions

Who can apply

If the child or young person is registerable on the Richmond upon Thames disability register (www.richmond.gov.uk/disabled_childrens_register), is under 18 years old, and is living in the London Borough of Richmond, then they or their family can apply for this one-off short break grant of up to £250 each year.

The application process takes two to three weeks for children already on the disability register; the process for those registering can take much longer.

The deadline for applications is 5 January 2015. Evidence that the grant has been used as agreed must be returned by 27 February 2015.

There is a finite amount of money for grants, so please make your application soon to avoid disappointment.

What could you use your grant for?

- Towards a family holiday or short break, such as Butlins, Centre Parcs, Haven or 'Give them a break'
- For entrance fees for a fun day out, such as Merlin pass to theme parks, day fees to animal parks, theme parks, concerts or museums
- Towards a residential holiday for your disabled child, such as with scouts or the Calvert Trust
- To pay for support from a paid worker for your disabled child on a day trip or outing with or without the family
- Towards transport or other necessary costs for a family activity together

What your grant cannot be used for

The grant cannot be used for equipment or items such as laptops, iPads, bikes, clothes or toys. If you are at all unsure about what you can or cannot use the grant for please contact **access** and we will be happy to guide you.
