## **A careers 'takeover' day for children**

JLT and House/Vice captains will run the stations and adults will supervise.

Each child would bring in £2 to cover costs of the school. The £2 is exchanged for 4 x Kew vouchers that they can use at whichever station they want.

Children must sign up in advance. At break, children will be able to move between sites. There will be a half time transfer when a child may do 2 activities in

Each station represents a career or job. Each class converts their room into this shop/business, provides resources/role play etc. The class chooses the station. For example (*ideas from JLT*):

- Garage Repair – *Making and repairing scooters, cleaning bikes and scooters. Filling out bills, invoices, order forms*
- Bank – *issuing loans, opening accounts, buying shares, dealing with complaints*
- Vets/toy hospital – *Caring for toy animals, operations, speaking to owners, diagnosis...*
- School (!) – *Taking different lessons, teaching, supporting, marking...*
- Pizza/Ice Cream parlour or café – *Using the funds raised to buy pizza materials, making, distributing, writing bills, taking money*
- Drama School – *acting, singing, dancing – Some performing at the following Monday Assembly*
- Sports Camp – *football training, skills, cricket, rounders, badminton*
- Computer Programmers / Pixar-Google type
- Newspaper Office
- Music Production
- Emergency Services
- Airport/Bus station etc.

For health and safety purposes, any food station or activity with a health and safety need, will be run by adults.

**This is not a hobbies afternoon. It is about engaging children to consider the skills they will need to practise to do the jobs they think they want to do!**

The day will look like this...

Session 1 – 9.15 to 9.45

Session 2 – 9.50 to 10.20

Break – at school or field. Site swap for those children changing activities.

Session 3 – 10.40 to 11.10

Session 4 – 11.15 – 11.45
