Fit For Sport offers **breakfast club** between 7.30am and 9.00am. The children have the opportunity to have a healthy breakfast in the company of their friends. They will have the opportunity to participate in a wide range of activities including; games quizzes, board games or reading in the quiet area before being taken to their classrooms for the start of their day. The cost of breakfast club is **£4.00 per session**.

Fit For Sport also run the **afterschool club** which runs from 3.15pm until 6.15pm and offers the children a fun, enjoyable and familiar environment beyond the school day. Every day children can enjoy and experience a wide choice of activities from; games, arts and crafts, sports, quizzes, board games, talent shows and quiet areas.
