



Appendix 1: Written statement of behaviour principles

At the heart of our policy is the promotion of positive behaviour. The whole school community has agreed to the following six Golden Rules:

1. Be kind and helpful
2. Be gentle
3. Look after property
4. Listen to people and show respect
5. Work hard
6. Be honest

Every pupil has the right to feel safe, valued, respected and included

We have high expectations of pupils' behaviour

Pupils are encouraged to reflect on and take responsibility for their actions

Pupils are encouraged to work together to resolve disagreements and restore relationships

All pupils, staff and visitors are treated fairly and with respect

Staff and volunteers are expected to be excellent role models of behaviour for pupils

Positive reinforcement, sanctions and reasonable force are used consistently and as necessary by staff

We work openly and constructively with parents and carers when there are behavioural incidents involving their child

Exclusions will only be used as a last resort

The behaviour policy is understood by pupils and staff

This written statement of behaviour principles is reviewed and approved by the Kew Riverside Primary School Board of Governors annually.
