Guided Reading - Volcanoes

LO: To retrieve and record information from a text.

This week, read the included text on 'Volcanoes'. There are three versions so choose the one which feels right for you.

Monday: Read the text and answer the comprehension questions below. Remember to always refer back to the text to help find the answer. If there are any words that you are unsure of, remember to sound them out using your phonic skills. If you don't know the meaning of the word, try looking it up in a dictionary.

Tuesday: Re-read the text. What new information did you learn about volcanoes? Do you know the names of any famous volcanoes around the world? Complete the sheets 'Labelling a Volcano' and 'Famous Volcanoes'.

Wednesday: Using the information from the text and your two sheets from yesterday, create a poster on volcanoes. It can be volcanoes in general or you may want to pick one from around the world to focus on. You might want to research volcanoes further using non-fiction books or the internet. What is the most important information you want the reader to know? Remember to add titles, sub headings and pictures onto your poster so that it stands out!

Thursday: Complete the 'Volcanoes' word search and then create your own for a family member to complete. Maybe you can include some of the new vocabulary you learnt this week!

Friday: Have a go at making your own volcano using objects from around your house! If you don't have all these objects then maybe add this activity to something you can do in future weeks. You can always sit and read a good book!
