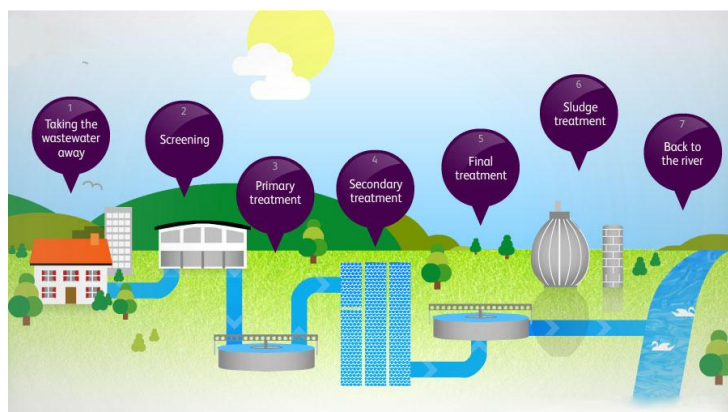
I could see trees and traffic lights. What a stunning view!
