**Criteria for Success** 

To gain any of the Head's Awards, your folder must have the following:

A clean, well-presented Head's Folder (lever arch or smaller) containing:

- Dividers separating evidence for each of the four areas
- Evidence inside punched pockets
- The folder <u>must be named</u> and a <u>clear indication of which award you are going for at the front.</u>
- Ticked success criteria in the front.
- All writing must follow Kew Riverside presentation rules
  - o Felt tips and broad-nibbed colouring pens are used in decoration only
  - Underline the criteria and date it
- Spellings must be correct

Folders that do not follow the above guidelines will be returned to the pupil.
