Let's Explore London






English






Science

Relationships

As good citizens we will be:

- Identifying the members of my family and understanding that there are lots of different types of families.

- Explaining why I appreciate someone who is special to me.



As Mathematicians we will be learning:



Multiplication & Division:

Count in 2's, 5's and 10's. We will make equal groups and begin to add equal groups.

Maths

Make arrays and learn our doubles.

Fractions:

- Recognise a half of an object or shape.
- Find a half of a quantity or shape.
- Recognise a quarter of a quantity or shape.

Throughout our learning we will deepen our knowledge by reasoning and problem solving investigations.

PE

As athletes, we will be looking at **athletics** where we will:

- Know and understand quicker and slower ways of travelling
- Develop fundamental movement skills. E.g. hopping, skipping and jumping



Engage in competitive and cooperative physical activities in a range of increasingly challenging situations

Music

As musicians our learning will be based around Big Bear Funk. The children will learn to listen and appraise music. Thinking about what they can hear and communicative what they like and dislike. They will also learn to play a variety of musical games and instrument.

Home Learning
