English

Computing

As **computer scientists** the children will be learning to:

- recognise common uses of information technology beyond school.
- use technology safely and respectfully, keeping personal information private; identify where to go for help and support when they have concerns about content or contact on the internet or other online technologies.

Science

As scientists we will be looking at plants! We will observe and describe how seeds and bulbs grow into mature plants and explain how plants need water, light and a suitable temperature to grow and stay healthy. We will then observe and describe changes of plants over time.



History

As historians, Cherry Class will Meet Florence Nightingale and Mary Seacole, two of the most famous historical figures. They will find out about their remarkable lives as they journey through lessons about their youth, famous voyages, and the work they did, as well as the work they did in her later years to improve nursing and hospital care.

Maths

As **Mathematicians** we will be learning to:

Y1

- Measurement: Length and Height Measure and begin to record lengths and heights.
- Compare, describe and solve practical problems for: lengths and heights (for example, long/short, longer/shorter, tall/short, double/half).
- Measurement: Weight and Volume Measure and begin to record mass/weight, capacity and volume.
- Compare, describe and solve practical problems for mass/weight:[for example, heavy/light, heavier than, lighter than]; capacity and volume [for example, full/empty, more than, less than, half, half full, quarter].

Y2

- Choose and use appropriate standard units to estimate and measure length/height in any direction (m/cm); mass (kg/g); temperature (°C); capacity (litres/ml) to the nearest appropriate unit, using rulers, scales, thermometers and measuring vessels.
- Compare and order lengths, mass, volume/capacity and record the results using $>$, $<$ and $=$.

Throughout our learning we will deepen our knowledge by reasoning and problem solving investigations.



PSHE

Healthy me

As good citizens we will be:

- Understanding what I need to keep my body healthy.
- Showing or telling what relaxed means and understanding some things that make me feel relaxed and some things that make me feel stressed.
- Understanding how medicines work in my body and how it is important to use them safely.
- Sorting foods into the correct food groups and knowing which foods my body needs every day to keep my healthy.
- Making some healthy snacks and explaining why they are good for my body.



PE

As athletes we will playing handball! We will be using what we have worked on so far this year, catching, throwing and agility, and applying these skills in groups and match settings. We will look at how we can pass and move into space whilst also identifying how we can use tactics to attack and defend as a team.
