



Let's Go to the Jungle

English

As authors we will be writing descriptive pieces about the setting from Lila and the Secret of the Rain describing the landscape before and after the rain and making comparisons. Cherry Class will also be writing a diary entry about Lila's journey.

Finally, the children will be using the beautiful text The Tear Thief to write instructions about how to make the moon shine.





RE

As philosophers we will be learning all about the Christian rites of passage.

The children will learn all about the important life events for Christians. They will learn about baptisms, communion, marriages and funerals in a fun and informative way.

Geography

As Geographers, Cherry Class will explore features of forest you and will learn all about jungles: Indian seasonal tropical forests, mangrove swamps and mountain cloud forests are all explored with beautiful, detailed photos included in every slide show. The children will learn all about some of our most beautiful, fragile, important biomes as they journey through some of the world's most fascinating jungles! The children will compare this to a woodland area in the UK and embark on fieldwork.



Science

As scientists we will be looking at living things and their habitats! We will be looking at:

- Identifying and naming a variety of common wild and garden plants, including deciduous and evergreen trees
- identifying and describing the basic structure of a variety of common flowering plants, including trees.
- Finding out and describing how plants need water, light and a suitable temperature to grow and stay healthy.

Maths

As Mathematicians we will be learning to:

Multiplication & Division:

- Count in 2's, 5's and 10's. We will make equal groups and begin to add equal groups.
- Make arrays and learn our doubles.

- Recognise a half of an object or shape.
- Find a half of a quantity or shape.
- Recognise a quarter of a quantity or shape.

Yr 2

Fractions

- Recognise equal and unequal parts.
- Recognise and find: a half, quarter, third and three-quarters.
- Learn Understand what unit and non-unit fractions.
- Count in fractions

Time

- Understand O'clock, half past, quarter past and quarter to the hour.
- Tell the time: past and to the hour and in 5 minute intervals.
- Know how many minutes in an hour and hours in a day.

Throughout our learning we will deepen our knowledge by reasoning and problem solving investigations.

PE

As athletes we will be playing cricket where children will show understanding of rules and boundaries and using different techniques in game situations. Pupils will also learn the techniques of bowling over arm, picking up a ball one handed from the floor, throwing underarm, protect themselves from being struck by a ball.
