Dear Parents and Carers,

Juniper Hall 2017 Final Reminder for 20th – 22nd September 2015

Excitement is building for our residential trip to Juniper Hall! Nell, Josh and I will be attending the trip and we are all ready for action! Please read the following information to help ensure that your child is well prepared for the trip.

On Wednesday 20th September we will be leaving school at **11.00am**. Children can come into school at the usual time or by **10.30am** at the latest.

As the weather is unpredictable at present, we should prepare for wet weather whilst we are away. Please ensure that your child has warm clothing and a waterproof coat. Children will also need closed sturdy footwear - trainers /walking boots would be best. Please supply spare footwear and lots of socks as there are no drying facilities. Please refer to the kit list for further guidance on clothing. For pond-dipping, **waterproofs and wellies can be borrowed from Juniper Hall** or children can bring their own. Children do not need to wear school uniform to school on the day of the trip.

We will be having a picnic lunch upon arrival so please can you provide your child with a packed lunch. Please pack their lunch in **disposable** bag. If your child has school meals they will be provided with a packed lunch. The children also need a small rucksack.

If your child requires any medication, please ensure they have sufficient supplies, it is in date and it is in a labelled container with quantity guidance. Please **hand this to Lisa** upon arrival at school on the **Wednesday 20th Septemeber**.

As mentioned in the previous letter, there is a shop and we have agreed that children can bring up to **£5.00 in their own labelled wallet**.

If you would like to write your child a **letter** for them to read during the trip, please do so. We will store it safely for you and hand them out on **Thursday**. **Please hand letters and money to Lisa on Wednesday 20th September**.

Children should leave mobile phones or any electronic devices/games at home. A good reading book would be perfect for any quiet time or before bed. Children can bring an item that reminds them of home if they wish. In the past children hav packed small teddies, photos and games.

Please do not pack any stationery. The company will provide everything the children will need.

On **Friday 22nd September**, we will arrive back at school at approximately 3.00pm. We will be in regular contact with Lisa to give an up-to-date arrival time during the journey home. As the children will have luggage, please could you ensure that your child is met by an adult to travel home rather than walking home alone.
