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School Results Report 2017-2018

Dear Parents and Carers

Time to celebrate! It is with great pleasure that I can announce our SATs, Phonics and EYFS results for 2017-18.

The 'Floor Standard' is a Government determined national target that states how many children per year group are anticipated to achieve the expected level of learning (EXS) for their age group in core subjects. The Floor Standard for this academic year was set at 65%.

Please note that these results provide a measure of the pupils' <u>attainment</u> against this target; they do not provide a measure of the <u>progress</u> made by the pupils, each of whom has a different learning journey. Therefore the results provide only a partial picture of what each child has achieved.

In KS2, Kew Riverside's score exceeds national results in most greas. This is an excellent result.

In KS1, you will see there is a dip in the scores compared to last year. This is due to higher levels of need within the cohort and of movement of pupils into and away from the school. As a one-form entry school, each of our children represents 3.3% (assuming a class of 30). Children who are new to the school and/or learning English as a new language, or have special needs are not assessed but are included in the cohort size. So if, for example, three children in a class of 30 fall into these categories, that can impact results by 10%. I hope this helps provide context for this year's results. All of the children are on a learning journey and we are confident that their progress indicates higher levels of attainment can be achieved going forward.

My sincere thanks go to all the staff for their hard work and dedication throughout the year, to you for your support at home and, of course, to all the children.
