Options

Children who have not been allocated their first choice this term will have the opportunity to take part in the spring or summer term instead.

Each option lasts for a whole term; each child will have three options per year unless they are involved in swimming extension sessions and/ or are in Y5 and Y6, in which case the children will be rehearsing for the school production in the summer term.

If your child has been selected for extension school swimming, please can you make the payment as soon as possible.


