Monday

LO: retell the story using role play and a story map

Tasks for today:

1. Watch the story being read in my video.
2. Talk about the events of the story – ask and answer questions about it.
3. Act out the story using role play – talk about how the characters feel and why.
4. Use a story map to show me the events of the story in the right order (look at the example I have started on the next slide)

Remember, a story map doesn't have to be perfectly drawn! It just needs to make sense to you.

Thursday

LO: use interesting sentence starters when we write a diary entry for Belle about her trip.

Tasks for today:

1. Re-watch the story being read in my video.
2. Use your story map to help remind you of the events that happened to Belle in the story.
3. Write a diary entry in role as Belle about your adventure - remember to use **interesting sentence starters!!**
