Incident in our Community

Further to my email this week regarding the violent incident that occurred last Saturday new Chaucer Road and Lambert Avenue, we have received the following advice from the police:

This incident is thankfully isolated in nature and we have had no similar crimes reported on either ward before or since.

We would therefore encourage teenagers out at night to be aware of their surroundings, restricting mobile phone usage to only when necessary; and to travel where possible in groups rather than in ones or twos.

Similarly, it might be prudent to keep parents or other friends updated with their evening plans and who they are meeting up with etc.

Sticking to well-lit and heavily trafficked routes is also advisable, instead of using more secluded footpaths even if more convenient.

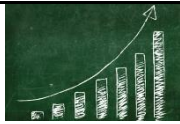
KewZania

Richmond Park Academy Open Evening

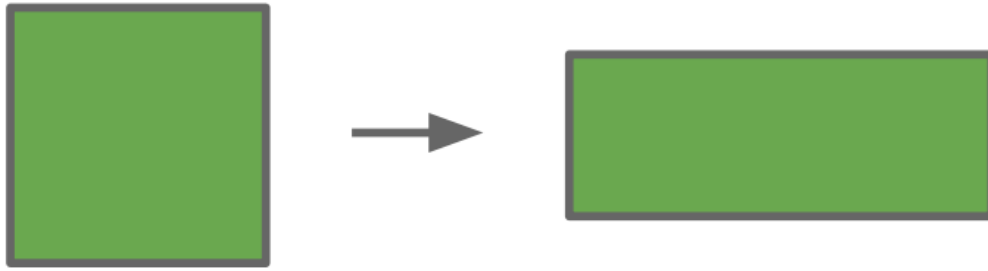
