# Richmond Borough in Bloom POSTER DESIGN COMPETITION 2016

*in co-operation with Achieving for Children* 

Pupils of all ages who attend a school within the borough of Richmond upon Thames are invited to submit a colourful, eyecatching painting of flowers seen outside in summertime. The entry chosen as best overall will be used to illustrate a special poster to publicise this year's gardening and floral display competitions; it is displayed in libraries and elsewhere throughout the borough.

The paintings will be judged in five age categories of entrants, from under 5 years to sixth form (see the box next page) and there will be a winner and two runners-up in each age category. All these 15 top entries will go on exhibition at special events during the year.

### What the judges are looking for

- \* Does this painting show artistic talent, taking account of age?
- \* Does it depict one or more flowers or shrubs seen in gardens during the summer months?
- \* Does it reveal a keen observation of blooms?
- \* Is the painting as a whole colourful and eye-catching from across the room?

#### The awards

For each of the top 15 selected across all 5 age categories - a commemorative Richmond Borough in Bloom certificate and a **prize pack of art materials** giving many hours of enjoyment. *Award winners will be invited to a special ceremony and celebration tea party*.

The overall winner will also receive a unique commemorative trophy to treasure for lifetime.

Each school whose pupil is a category winner will be awarded a special Richmond Borough in Bloom **commemorative certificate** to display.

#### How to enter

Entries may be submitted through the school the pupil attends or they can be sent directly to the address shown next page. This means an entry may be part of a class project or pupils may like to take their own initiative by creating a painting in the Easter holiday or at other free times.

#### **HOW TO FNTFR**

#### Conditions

- 1 You must be attending a school within the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames.
- 2 Pictures may be in paint, crayon, ink or felt pen (but not computer generated) on a sheet no larger than A4 (29.7x21cm) and must not be mounted.
- 3 Only pictures in portrait shape will be accepted and the picture must not contain any words or figures.
- 4 Award winning entries will be retained by Richmond Borough in Bloom and may be put on display or reproduced. The organisers do not undertake to return any other entries.

5 Your entry must be submitted through your school, or direct to the address below, by the closing date of Friday April 22<sup>nd</sup> 2016.

- 6 You must affix a label or write directly onto the back of the picture stating:
- a) Your full name (in capitals)
- b) The age (in years) you will be on Friday April 22<sup>nd</sup> 2016
- c) The age category entered A, B, C, D, or E
- d) The name of your school.

Entries without all these details will be disqualified.

If you are an individual entrant, please enclose a note giving the name, phone and email address of your parent or guardian.

The entries will be judged in five age groups.
