

The Moor Lane Centre, Moor Lane, Chessington, KT9 2AA

How to find us:

Bus: Take the 71 bus to the Church Rise stop.

Car: Take the A3 and come off at the Hook Junction and take the first exit off the roundabout (A243). At the next roundabout take the first exit onto Bridge Road. At the next roundabout the first exit onto Mount Road (The Moor Lane Centre is signposted) then at the next immediate roundabout take the third exit right (also signposted). A small slip road will take you up to the Moor Lane Centre.

Train: Take a Southwest Train to Chessington North. Trains arrive/ depart twice an hour from this station. The Moor Lane Centre is a short walk from here.

There will be restricted parking at the centre on the day of the event so please use public transport if you are able to.

* Please note, this station does not have step free access. The nearest accessible station is Surbiton; the 71 bus stop is situated close to the station.





