### IMPORTANT INFORMATION TO PARENTS :-

Parents should select Kew Riverside School, TW9 4ES before completing the form and **ONLY complete one form for each child**, taking care to enter all details correctly and ensuring that the correct Year Group between Reception (0) and - Year 6 is selected in line with their child's DOB. Any changes to the form will need to be made by the Immunisation Team as duplicating a form will present problems.

The link to the consent form for Kew Riverside School will close **at midnight on Thursday, 2nd December 2021**. Parents will not be able to submit consent for the session after this date so we would ask that forms are **completed early, confirming either YES or NO to the vaccine**. (Nb. If saying NO, parents should select the reason for declining from the drop-down list.)
