

This week we have had two special assemblies on the importance and significance of Remembrance Day. On Wednesday Rhiannon led an assembly based on her father who currently serves in the armed forces and how this enriched her childhood experiences. In assembly today we discussed the significance of wearing a poppy and thought back to the very first Remembrance Day which took place on 11<sup>th</sup> November 1919 following the first World War. At 11am the whole school gathered together in the playground for two minutes silence, during which we remembered all those who have died in wars around the world. Each class also made their own wreaths of remembrance to display around the school.
