Helping children with challenging behaviours

Children often communicate their needs through their behaviours. The 'Helping Children with challenging behaviours' webinar will help you to learn about the different factors that can impact children's behaviours, build or strengthen positive relationships by reinforcing the importance of giving positive attention. You will also learn strategies to establish home rules and boundaries to create a safe and structured environment for your child/ren.

What will the 'Helping Children with challenging behaviours' webinar cover?

- The different factors influencing children's behaviours
- Strategies to build positive relationships and encourage prosocial behaviours
- Evidence-based techniques to reduce undesirable behaviours
- Emotional regulation
