

WRITING - Fiction Narratives (stories) - Lesson 1 of 4 (Monday)

For the next two weeks we are going to be focusing on **fiction writing** and fiction writing skills. We haven't completed any story writing during the school closure so I am really looking forward to seeing your impressive skills in this area of writing. **We will be focusing on using the short video story 'Powerless - The Modern Day Pinocchio'.**

Lesson 1 - LO: To identify nouns and adjectives.

1) Watch the video twice through. Think about the following questions or discuss them with a friend via video calling/phone (check with a grownup first).

- Where is the story taking place?
- Who are the characters in the story?
- What is the relationship between the characters?
- What might happen next?

2) We are focusing on identifying **nouns** and **adjectives** today - can you remember what they are?

Example:

Nouns: house, man, robot, forest

Adjectives: dark, dim, spooky
