### Task 1:

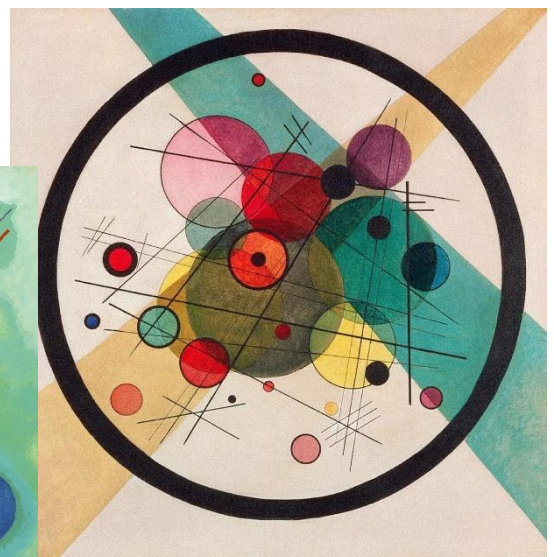

Have a look at some of his art work below and discuss the answers with a family member or friend (over video call/email). Use these sentence starters and frames if you need some help:

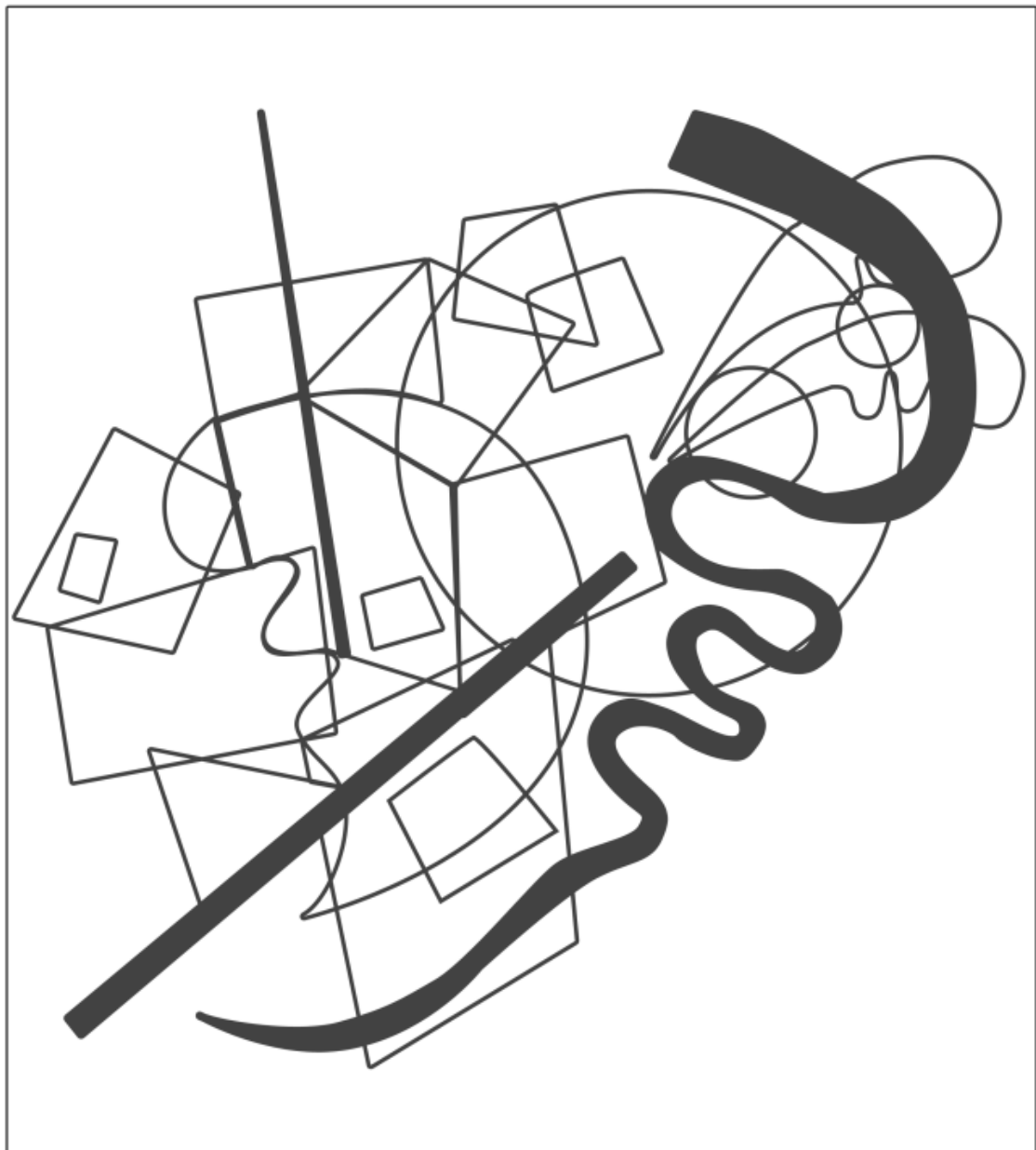
