



Guided Reading – Roald Dahl

LO: To retrieve and record information from a text.

This week, read the included text on 'Roald Dahl'. There are three versions so choose the one which feels right for you.

Monday: Read the text and answer the comprehension questions below. Remember to always refer back to the text to help find the answer. If there are any words that you are unsure of, remember to sound them out using your phonic skills. If you don't know the meaning of the word, try looking it up in a dictionary.

Tuesday: Re-read the text. What information have you learnt about Roald Dahl? Did you know any of your own facts before reading the text? Use the 'fact file' sheet to write a biography on Roald Dahl using information from the text as well as any of your own facts. Remember, you aren't just copying the sentences into a new page but re-writing the information in your own words. There are different versions of the sheet to choose from so pick the one that feels right for you.

Wednesday: One of my favourite Roald Dahl stories is 'Charlie and the Chocolate Factory' because I love all of the different characters and how unique they are. Use the 'character writing frames' to write about a character of your choice, or maybe you want to have a go at more than one! There is a word bank to help you. If you don't know this story then perhaps choose a different Roald Dahl book and write about your favourite character from that – Mr and Mrs Twit maybe!

Thursday: Complete the word search and crossword and then create your own for a family member to complete. Maybe you can include some of the new vocabulary you learnt this week!

Friday: Today I would just like you to read for pleasure! Choose a good book, snuggle down and enjoy 😊
