Using a mix of real and replica historical objects from the Museum's handling collection, our workshops provide families with a hands on experience where they learn more about the history of the local area, develop new skills by having a go at arts and craft activities, and spend quality time together.

Our workshops are led by our Learning Officer, Vicky, who has over ten years of experience of working with families and has an Enhanced DBS check.

Workshops are primarily aimed at children aged 5-11 years old. For children aged 11 and over, we can make the activities more challenging for them. Children must be accompanied by an adult at all times.

If younger siblings (under 5s) are coming as well and not taking part in the main craft activity, we can provide colouring materials for them free of charge, as the workshop charges are to help us cover the cost of craft materials.

When booking, please book places for adults and under 5s, as this lets us know how many chairs we need to put out for the workshop.

A week long course looking at arts and crafts used to decorate places of worship. Students will develop new skills, learn more about the history of Richmond, and earn a Bronze Arts Award - a Level 1 qualification (equivalent to a GCSE - grades 3, 2, 1 or grades D, E, F, G) from Trinity College, London

### Activities will include:

- Visiting and reviewing the St Mary Magdalene's exhibition at both the Church and the Museum
- Look at the similarities and differences in how different faiths decorate their places of worship.
- Having a go at arts and crafts associated with places of workshop including stained 'glass', geometric patterns and stylised flora and fauna.
- Curating an exhibition of their work which will remain on display at the Museum for the duration of the St Mary Magdalene's Exhibition
